**Women's Bond Club Committee sign-ups**

Below is a brief description of each committee and the types of activities managed by the groups. **Community Outreach** – Co-Chaired by Board members Jeannette Martin ([jmmartin@deloitte.com](mailto:jmmartin@deloitte.com)) and Karen Goldman ([Karen.Goldman@barcap.com](mailto:Karen.Goldman@barcap.com)). This committee runs the Club's charitable giving program as well as the scholarship, mentoring and internship jobs programs. Your involvement would include working directly with promising young women interested in building a career in business and finance, liaising with charitable organizations, coordinating scholarship and mentoring programs and more. The time commitment can range between 2 to 10 hours per month depending upon your role and planned activities. Monthly meetings are held via conference call with quarterly optional in-person sessions.

**Events** – Co-Chaired by Board Members Mayra Sacco ([mayra.sacco@bnymellon.com](mailto:mayra.sacco@bnymellon.com)) and Mary Caracappa ([mary.caracappa@morganstanley.com](mailto:mary.caracappa@morganstanley.com)). This committee plans our monthly events with the corporate sponsor firms who host the events. Committee work includes identifying a corporate member firm(s) to host and assisting the event host with brainstorming concepts for each event. At times, the committee members may need to assist at the actual event by greeting and registering guests. The time commitment averages 2 to 3 hours per event. Work can be performed individually or as part of a team of committee members. Most of the work required can be done over the telephone with in-person meetings occasionally. The Committee as a group meets monthly either in-person or via a conference call.

**Merit Award Dinner** – Co-Chaired by Board members Heidi Solomon ([heidi.solomon@credit-suisse.com](mailto:heidi.solomon@credit-suisse.com)) and Myra Woods ([myra.woods@rbc.com](mailto:myra.woods@rbc.com)). The committee plans the Club's annual fundraising event, the Merit Award Dinner, which will be held in April 2011. The Merit Award Dinner is an exciting event and there are many opportunities to contribute. You can work on the nominations for the Merit Award, Isabel Benham Award and the Rising Stars, sell tables or liaise with the event planner to ensure that we have a very special evening. We meet weekly by phone from October through April. The time commitment increases as the event nears with most participants spending 4+ hours per month in the three months preceding the event.

**Targeted Programs Committee** - Chaired by Board member Siobhan Dunn ([Siobhan.Dunn@morganstanley.com](mailto:Siobhan.Dunn@morganstanley.com)). This committee focuses on coordinating events and programs targeted to specific groups within the Women's Bond Club: the Rising Star Program and the Senior Women's Dinner. Committee members ensure that events reach the intended audience and achieve our objectives. We work closely with the Events Committee to align schedules with the general membership, events and sponsors. We also serve as a platform to implement any new Women's Bond Club events. The time commitment is 1 to 3 hours per month with increasing involvement leading into the start of a program. Meetings are usually held via conference call with one or two in person meetings over dinner per year.

**Marketing & Communications** – Chaired by Board member Linda Wittich ([linda.wittich@broadridge.com](mailto:linda.wittich@broadridge.com)). This committee runs all marketing and communications associated with the Women's Bond Club and is responsible for promoting our brand: "Lead. Learn. Return." On an on-going basis, we share our message through newsletters, brochures, website and social media platforms. Projects for this year include website optimization, building an active press strategy and focusing on awareness of monthly events and key activities. The time commitment is flexible and typically is 4 to 8 hours per month, including monthly team meetings that rotate between phone calls and in-person sessions.

**Corporate Outreach and Membership** – Co-Chaired by Board members Karen Lorentz ([klorentz@nyx.com](mailto:klorentz@nyx.com)) and Andrea Ianniello ([aianniello@optonline.net](mailto:aianniello@optonline.net)). This committee identifies target firms, educates decision makers about the benefits of the Women's Bond Club and initiates the on-boarding of new members. Committee members also work with existing corporate members to maximize the value of their membership and to tee up new initiatives as appropriate. The Committee also provides services to individual members. The time commitment is 5 to 10 hours per month including a monthly committee conference call. Except for the monthly call, all committee work can be done as and when the committee members' schedules permit.

This committee performs various activities to ensure our financial integrity. The time commitment is 5 to 10 hours per month including a monthly committee conference call.
